From 1 July 2025 to 11 August 2025 (30 working days) the accounts and other documents will be available for inspection; application should be made initially via the following e-mail address – corporate.accounting@nottscc.gov.uk

NOTICE is also given that for a 30-working day statutory period from 1 July 2025 to 11 August 2025, a local elector (that is anyone who has a right to vote in local government elections for the Nottinghamshire County Council) may personally or by a representative ask the Auditor questions about the accounts. A local elector may also in the same 30 working day statutory period, either personally or by a representative, make objections to anything about which the Auditor could take action under section 28 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. Those sections deal with expenditure made by the County Council which is unlawful, and any matter in respect of which the auditor could make a public interest report under Section 27 of the Act.

A local elector who wishes to make an objection must first make sure that the Auditor has received a written notice setting out the objection and the grounds on which it is to be made and must send a copy of that notice to the County Council for the attention of the County Council's Monitoring Officer.
