This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath and the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The Newark and Sherwood District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Southwell and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be footpath over the land situate at Southwell described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

PART 1

The full width of the affected length of footputh No. 69

Commencing from a point, SK 7071 5388, at a junction with Southwell Footpath No.68 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 133 m in a north-westerly direction to a point SK 7058 5392, the remains of Southwell Footpath No.69.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

A Footpath

Commencing from a point, SK 7069 5388at a junction with Southwell Footpath No.68 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 132 m in a generally westerly to north-north-westerly direction to a point SK 7058 5392, the remains of Southwell Footpath No.69.

The footpath will have a width of 2 metres throughout.
