

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS**

### **THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** **(KERSALL FOOTPATH NO.2 AND NO.4 AND MAPLEBECK FOOTPATH NO.3)** **(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Kersall Footpath No.2 and No.4 and Maplebeck Footpath No.3) Notice 2025 (which came into force on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 11<sup>th</sup> February 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 11<sup>th</sup> August 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall:-

- (a) No person shall proceed on foot,

in the following lengths of Footpath at Kersall and Maplebeck in the District of Newark and Sherwood:

**Kersall Footpath No.2 and No.4 and Maplebeck Footpath No.3**, where they cross the footbridge over the beck, at the path junction, on the parish boundary, at Grid Reference SK 7032 6216.

**AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route available for pedestrians.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required due to protect public safety due to a badly damaged footbridge which requires replacement.
