

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **(MARNHAM FOOTPATH NO.3 AND NORMANTON FOOTPATH NO.1)** **(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Marnham Footpath No.3 and Normanton Footpath No.1 (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2024 (which came into force on 12th November 2024 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 11th May 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 11th May 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Marnham and Normanton in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Marnham Footpath No.3 continuing as Normanton Footpath No.1

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows:-

Marnham Footpath No.6 and Normanton Footpath No.9 and vice versa

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety following damage to the footbridge on the parish boundary, and to facilitate repair or replacement of the bridge.
