



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STANTON-ON-THE-WOLDS FOOTPATH
NO.6) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STANTON-ON-THE-WOLDS FOOTPATH NO.6) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE 2026.

That Notice came into force on 1st May 2026.

The effects are that:-

No person shall:-

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Stanton-On-The-Wolds in the Borough of Rushcliffe.

Stanton-on-the-Wolds Footpath No.6 from its start point at the junction with A606 Melton Road SK 63838 31167 to where it meets the River Smite at SK69684 32306 to its junction with Stanton-on-the-Wolds Footpath No.12 SK 63692 31059.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows:-

There is no direct alternative route available.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To **1st November 2026** inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 22nd May 2026 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety until a new footbridge can be erected along this route.
