

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **(AWSWORTH FOOTPATH NO.10)** **(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Awsorth Footpath No.10) (Temporary Prohibition) Order 2025 (which came into force on 9th August 2025 and continues in force until 8th February 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 8th August 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Awsorth in the Borough of Broxtowe:-

Awsorth Footpath No.10 -the small section of path from the access road off Shilo Way, as shown on the attached plan.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows:-

A short non-definitive path will be available around the current access point

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable safe construction vehicle access for development to the north of the footpath, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.
