

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (REMPSTONE FOOTPATH NO.10) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Rempstone Footpath No.10) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025 (which came into force on 22nd January 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 21st July 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 21st January 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Rempstone in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

Rempstone Footpath No.10 from its junction with Wysall Road, to its junction with Rempstone Footpath No.7 and Rempstone Footpath No.8.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route available for pedestrians.

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to a damaged footbridge, and to enable repair or replacement of that bridge.
