




There are deadlines to apply for travel assistance before each school year. The deadlines are on <u>our website</u>.

Age related eligibility for travel assistance







Travel assistance begins at the start of the academic year which includes the child's fifth birthday.

Pupils aged four years and in full time education

Four year old pupils are entitled to free transport to the nearest school

This is from the start of the academic year until which they turn five if that school is two miles or more ÅÅÅ 5→7

ÅÅÅ 8 →1 1

ÅÅÅ 1 1⇒16

Pupils aged five to seven years

Pupils who must go to school and are aged under eight are entitled to free transport to the nearest suitable school if it is more than two miles from home.

Pupils aged eight to 11

Eight to 11 year old pupils are entitled to free transport to the nearest suitable school if it is more than three miles from home.

Pupils this age from low income families are entitled to free transport if the nearest school is more than two miles away.

Pupils aged 11 to 16

Pupils who attend secondary school are entitled to free transport to the nearest suitable school if it is more than three miles from home.



Pupils this age from low income families are entitled to free transport if the nearest school is between two and six miles from their home, and there are not three or more suitable nearer schools.

Faith Schools Transport





The rules are different for children from low income families attending faith schools.

Pupils aged between five and 16, attending the nearest suitable school preferred on grounds of religion or belief, are eligible for free transport if the school is between two and 20 miles from their home.

This service will be available for home to school travel on school days only.

Change in circumstances



Travel assistance will continue every year unless anything changes.



If anything changes, like moving house or changing school, you will need to re-apply

You will be reassessed as the changes might mean you no longer qualify.
