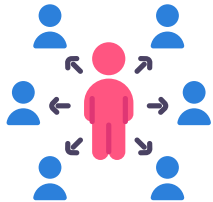
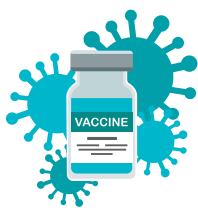


Measles cases are on the rise in England

You can get vaccinated for free on the NHS.

Children should receive the first dose at age one and the second at three years and four months.

Alternative non-porcine products (pork ingredients) are available if required.
