

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GREASLEY FOOTPATH NO.51 AND NO.52) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Greasley Footpath No.51 and No.52) (Temporary Prohibition) Order 2024 (which came into force on 20th June 2024 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order which came into force on 20th December 2024 and remains in force until 19th December 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 19th December 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following lengths of Footpath at Greasley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Greasley footpath No.51 and No.52 between Commons Close and Bridleway No.49.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be along Greasley Bridleway No.49.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable approved housing development and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpaths.
