

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 S118(A)
RAIL CROSSING STOPPING UP

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
BURTON JOYCE FOOTPATH NO.6

Network Rail has made an application to the Nottinghamshire County Council under Section 118(A) of the Highways Act 1980, which would extinguish the public right of way commencing from a point SK 6489 4367 south of Chestnut Grove and proceeding for a distance of approximately 20 metres across the railway to a point, SK 6490 4365 as shown on the displayed map.

The application is made on the grounds of public safety, due to misuse of the crossing and several near misses with trains. Information regarding the safety concerns is available on the Council Website at Rights of Way News, Burton Joyce Footpath No.6.

Alternative routes to reach Footpath 8 along the River Trent would be via Footpath No.7 and Bridleway No.5.

As part of the process to consider the application, The County Council are undertaking a pre-order consultation with utility companies, rights of way user groups, local authorities, the public and interested parties.
