

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(BABWORTH FOOTPATH NO. 9) DIVERSION ORDER 2026

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council (“the Authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath and the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The Bassetlaw District Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Babworth and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation and certification of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Babworth described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order.

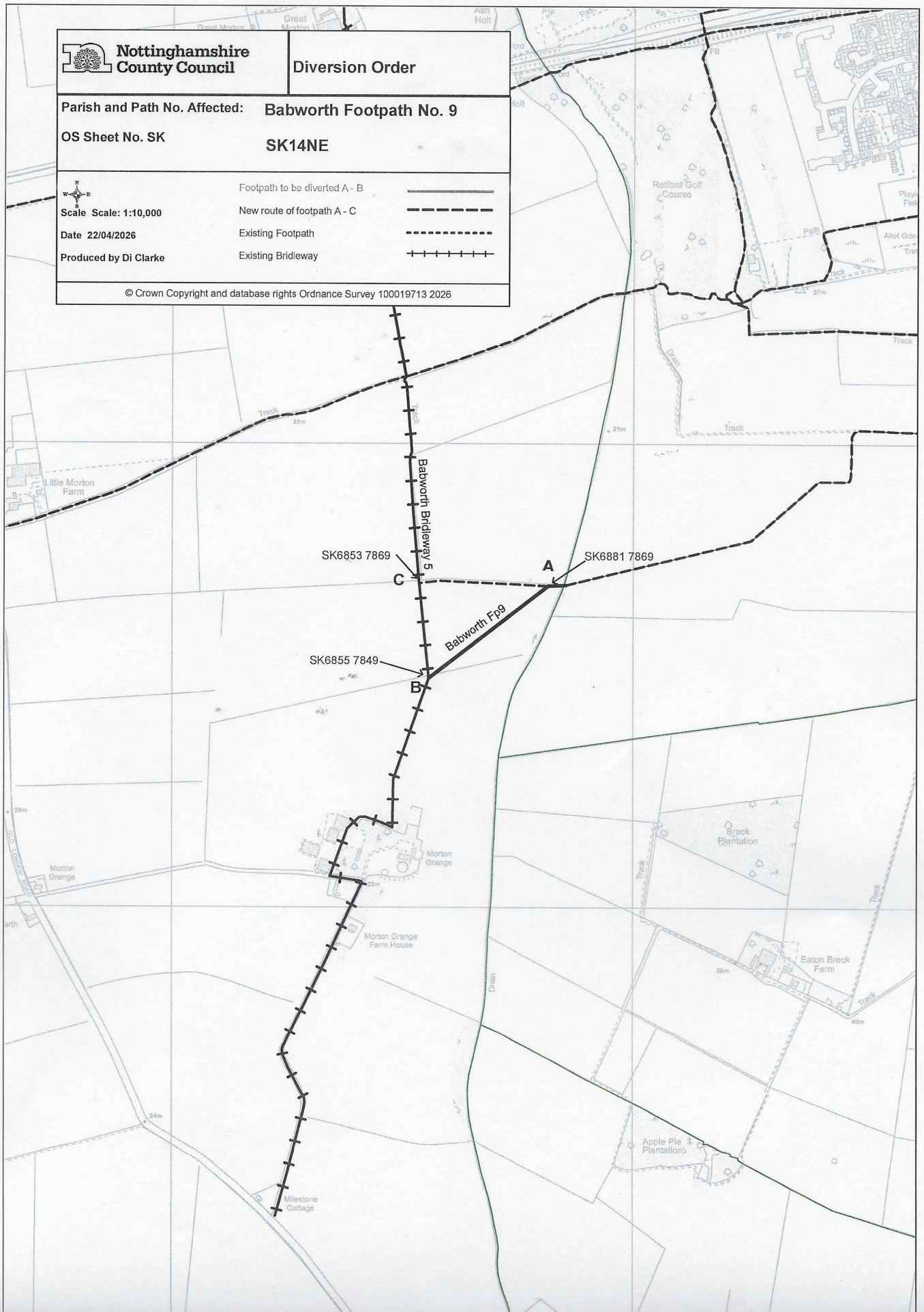

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That part of Babworth Footpath No.9 commencing from Point A [SK 6881 7869] proceeding in a South West direction across a field for a distance of approximately 321 metres to Point B [SK 6855, 7849] as shown on the order map.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Commencing from Point A [SK 6881 7869] proceeding in a Westerly direction along field edge for a distance of approximately 280 metres to Point C [SK 6853, 7869] at the junction with Bridleway 5 having a width of 1.5 metres as shown on the order map.
