

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(EDWINSTOWE BRIDLEWAY NO.6)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Edwinstowe Bridleway No.6) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025" (which came into force on 29th August 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 28th February 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 28th February 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed,
- (d) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following length of Bridleway at Edwinstowe in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Edwinstowe Bridleway No.6 (Boy Lane) from the A6075 Ollerton Road to the surfaced section of Boy Lane off the B6034 Rufford Road, a distance of 1130 metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available for bridleway users.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to Network Rail works access and obstruction/damage to the bridge over the River Maun.
