

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WORKSOP FOOTPATH NO.35)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.3 ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Worksop Footpath No.35 (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025" (which came into force on 6th March 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation order which remained in force until 5th September 2025 and was further continued by a Continuation No.2 Order which remains in force until 5th March 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 5th September 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Worksop in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Worksop Footpath No.35, its entire length between Eastgate and Kilton Road.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be along the footways of Eastgate and Kilton Road.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety, due to the damaged and dangerous condition of an adjoining wall, and to enable repairs to be made.
