

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LAMBLEY FOOTPATH NO.23)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Lambley Footpath No.23) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025 (which came into force on 29th August 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 28th February 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 28th February 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Lambley in the Borough of Gedling:-

Lambley Footpath No.23, from Catfoot Lane, along the dumble, to its junction with Footpath No.21, which is currently also closed over the footbridge (as shown on the accompanying plan).

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route available for pedestrians on public rights of way.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to a landslip on the footpath and to enable repairs to be carried out.
