

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CLIPSTONE BRIDLEWAY NO.3 AND NCN6)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall:-

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed and
- (d) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following length of bridleway at Clipstone in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

Clipstone Bridleway No. 3 (NCN Route 6) between its junction with Clipstone Bridleway No.5 at Vicar Pond and its junction with Clipstone Bridleway No.4, at Baulker Lane

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 1st September 2025 to 31st October 2025 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route will be via Clipstone Bridleway No.3, Clipstone Bridleway No.7, Mansfield Road and Baulker Lane and vice versa.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the path. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required due to enable drainage connection works in relation to approved development, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the path.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
