

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **(ARNOLD FOOTPATH NO.7)** **(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.3 ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Arnold Footpath No.7) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025" (which came into force on 7th January 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 6th July 2025 inclusive, and was then further continued by a Continuation No.2 Order until 6th July 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 6th January 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect: -

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Arnold in the Borough of Gedling:-

Arnold Footpath No.7 over the footbridge at grid reference SK 6005 4675, the bottom of the hill.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be over the field access bridge to the south of the footbridge and up through the wooded area on the permissive path provided by the landowner.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety following damage to the footpath bridge/crossing and to enable repair or diversion of footpath to be processed.
