What is the Community Learning Disability team?



The Community Learning Disability team supports people by doing assessments, giving advice, offering treatment and support for people with a learning disability and their carers.

The team has:







- Occupational therapists
- Physiotherapists







 Social workers and community care officers

• Speech and Language Therapists

In Nottinghamshire, there are 7 Community Learning Disability Teams:

Can I have help?



You have to be over 18 years of age, have a



learning disability and live in Nottinghamshire.

You need to have a referral for support.

This means you have to talk about your needs and tell them why you need support.

You should <u>contact the Council's Customer</u> <u>Service Centre</u> – they will try and help you with your problems.



You can ask someone who knows you well to help with this.




The team can provide information and advice or support with:

• Short Breaks






• Finding the right support

Once a referral has been accepted by the Community Learning Disability Team, someone will contact you.



They might make an appointment to see you. Sometimes they see people at:

Office



The team might make an assessment of your needs.

The team might help you make support plans around your needs.

Sometimes, a person's needs are very complicated and the team might ask another team to give more help to you.



Each team has a duty worker. This means that someone will be able to help with problems in an emergency.

It is important to let the team know if things change for you. This way you can get the right support.
