

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KIRKBY IN ASHFIELD FOOTPATH NO.86) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**KIRKBY IN ASHFIELD FOOTPATH NO.86**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2025**.

That Notice came into force on 25th June 2025 and was continued in force by a second 21-day notice that remains in force until 5th August 2025.

The effects are that:-

No person shall: - proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Kirkby in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield-

<u>Kirkby in Ashfield Footpath No.86</u>, From Felley Avenue to the playground, Skegby Road and The Steeples.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows: -

Felley Avenue and Skegby Road and vice versa

<u>IT IS INTENDED</u> that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 24th December 2025 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 6th August 2025 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect the public, while a boundary fence is made secure following a dog related incident.
