

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **(HALAM FOOTPATH NO.7)** **(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.4 ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of 'The Nottinghamshire County Council (Halam Footpath No.7) (Temporary Prohibition) Order 2024' (which came into force on 7th March 2024 and was continued in force by a continuation Order which remained in force until 6th September 2024 and was then continued by a continuation No.2 Order which remained in force until 6th September 2025 and was then continued by a continuation No.3 Order which remains in force until 6th March 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 6th September 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Halam in the District of Newark and Sherwood:

Halam Footpath No.7 where it crosses the footbridge over Halam Beck at Grid Reference SK 6757 5466

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows:-

Halam Footpath No.14, The Turnpike (Mansfield Road), and Halam Footpath No.6 and vice versa

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to a badly damaged footbridge and to enable its replacement.
