

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EAST MARKHAM FOOTPATH NO.25 & NO.24) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (<u>East Markham Footpath No.25</u>) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE <u>2025</u>.

That Notice came into force on 8th October 2025 and was continued in force by a second 21 Day Notice that came into force on 29th October 2025.

The effects are that:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at East Markham in the District of Bassetlaw-

East Markham Footpath No.25 and East Markham Footpath No. 24, the section alongside the railway track between East Markham Bridleway No.11 and where East Markham Footpath No.24 crosses the field.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available for pedestrians via public rights of way.

<u>IT IS INTENDED</u> that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows: -

To 7th April 2026 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 19th November 2025 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to erosion and overgrowth on the footpath.
