It is about getting help to speak up.

What does an Advocate do?



They listen to you and what you have to say.



They help you to look at your options.



They help you to make your own decisions.

They help you tell people like your family, staff and social workers what you want.

They help you make a complaint if you are unhappy with a service or the way you are treated.
