HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ORSTON FOOTPATH No.16) DIVERSION ORDER 2026

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The Rushcliffe Borough Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Orston and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation and certification of this Order.
2. There shall be upon confirmation and certification of this Order be a footpath over the land situate at Orston described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

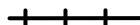

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

Commencing at point A at grid reference SK 7686 4079 at the junction with Orston Footpath No. 16 and running in a generally north-westerly direction across the vehicle access area serving Vale Cottage and passing directly in front of the dwelling for a distance of approximately 23 metres then continuing in a south south-westerly direction for approximately 9 metres to point B at grid reference SK 7685 4080 and the junction with the continuation of Orston Footpath No.16.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

Commencing at point A at grid reference SK 7686 4079, at the junction with Orston Footpath No. 16 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 25 metres in a generally west north-westerly direction over a paved surface to point B at grid reference SK 7685 4080 and the junction with the continuation of Orston FP16. The width of the footpath shall be 2 metres throughout its entire length.
