



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(KEYWORTH FOOTPATH NO.3)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**KEYWORTH FOOTPATH NO.3**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2025**.

That Notice came into force on 1st December 2025.

The effects are that: -

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Keyworth in the Borough of Rushcliffe-

Keyworth Footpath No.3, from its start point at the junction with Bridleways 5 and 7 at Keyworth to the Parish boundary with Wysall.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route on public rights of way, and any road alternatives should be used with caution.

A possible alternative is shown on the plan.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 31st May 2026 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 22nd December 2025 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to the footbridges on the path being in a damaged and dangerous condition, and to enable repair and replacement as necessary.
