## **THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A614/A6097 JUNCTIONS IMPROVEMENT SCHEME) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2022**

1. I am to inform you that the Secretary of State for Transport has confirmed the above-named Side Roads Order with modifications.
2. The Order will come into force on the date on which the Secretary of State publishes notice of its confirmation in the London Gazette, in accordance with paragraph 1 (1) of Schedule 2 to the Highways Act 1980. I enclose, for your information and distribution to any parties you think fit, a copy of the Notice of Confirmation of the Order which is due to be published on 8 February 2024. Arrangements have also been made by the Secretary of State for publication of the Notice in the Newark Advertiser and Nottingham Post. The Council may wish to check that the Notice does appear in the local newspaper on its scheduled date and on which date the Council may also be seeking to publish notice of confirmation of any related Compulsory Purchase Order.
3. In confirming your Order the Secretary of State has relied on the information that you have provided, as contained in the Order and any related plans, diagrams, statements or correspondence, as being factually correct. This confirmation is given on this basis.
4. Could you please arrange for a copy of the confirmed Order to be made available at the offices of the Council and at other places referred to in the published notice.
