

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WEST DRAYTON FOOTPATH NO.1) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.3 ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (West Drayton Footpath No.1) (Temporary Prohibition Notice 2023 (which came into force on 6th October 2023 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order which came into force on 27th October 2023 and was then continued in force by a Continuation No.2 Order which came into force on 6th April 2024 and remains in force until 5th April 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 5th April 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at West Drayton in the District of Bassetlaw: -

West Drayton Footpath No.1 between Mill Lane and Church Lane

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available on public rights of way.

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to a badly damaged footbridge and to enable works to replace the structure.
