

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (THORPE FOOTPATH NO.1) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Thorpe Footpath No.1) (Temporary Prohibition) Order 2025 (which came into force on 23rd February 2025 and continues in force until 22nd August 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 22nd February 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall:-

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of footpath at Thorpe in the District of Newark and Sherwood;

Thorpe Footpath No.1 where it crosses a timber footbridge over the drain at grid reference point SK 7660 5013

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available for pedestrians on public rights of way.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable repair works to footbridge to be carried out in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.
