This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that the Nottinghamshire (Area 7) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way subsist or are reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path.

The Authority have consulted with every Local Authority whose area includes land to which the Order relates.

The Nottinghamshire County Council hereby order that:


1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 5th December 2025
2. The Nottinghamshire (Area 7) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the Map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Edingley Footpath No. 1 and Kirklington Footpath No.14) Modification Order 2026".



SCHEDULE

PART I

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of the Path or Way to be added

Edingley Footpath No.1 (Part of)

Commencing from a point SK 6740 5663, marked A on the order plan, at the junction with the northern remainder of Edingley Footpath No.1 at a pedestrian gate in the northern boundary of Southwell Trail, and proceeding with a width of 1.8 metres in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 40 metres with no further limitations to a point SK 6740 5667, marked point B on the order plan, at the parish boundary with Kirklington and at the junction with Kirklington No.14.

Kirklington Footpath No.14

Commencing at a point SK 6740 5667, marked B on the order plan, at the parish boundary with Edingley and the junction with Edingley Footpath No.1, and proceeding with a width of 1.8 metres in a generally north-easterly direction with no limitations for a distance of approximately 497 metres to a point, SK 6752 5715, marked C on the order plan, at the junction with Southwell Road.

PART II

Modification of Definitive Statement

Variation of particulars of path or way

Edingley Footpath No.1

Commencing from a point, SK 6658 5586 at the junction with Main Street, and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 1,260 metres, following the west bank of Edingley Beck, crossing the track leading to Springs Farm at a point, SK 6705 5623, then continuing to a footbridge over Edingley Beck, just south of the dismantled railway and approximately 158 metres west of Ivy Cottage at a point, SK 6741 5656, then crossing the dismantled railway just south of the former station to a point, SK 6740 5663, at a pedestrian gate on the northern boundary of Southwell Trail Greenspace, and finally proceeding in a northerly direction on a grass and earth surface to a point, SK 6740 5667, at the parish boundary and the junction with Kirklington Footpath No.14, and having widths of 1 metre between points SK 6658 5586 and SK 6740 5663, and 1.8 metres between points SK 6740 5663 and SK 6740 5667.

Description of the Path or Way to be added.

Kirklington Footpath No. 14

Commencing from a point, SK 6740 5667, at the parish boundary with Edingley and the junction with Edingley Footpath No.1, and proceeding on an earth surface and with a width of 1.8 metres in a generally north-easterly direction with no limitations for a distance of approximately 497 metres to a point, SK 6752 5715, at the junction with Southwell Road.
