

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LINDHURST BRIDLEWAY NO.2)  
DIVERSION ORDER 2026

On 6<sup>th</sup> May 2026 the Nottinghamshire County Council confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the whole width of the public right of way commencing from a point SK 5673 5692 (marked A on the order plan), and proceeding in a south-easterly and then north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 114 metres to a point SK 5683 5693 (marked B on the order plan), as shown on the displayed map to a route commencing from a point SK 5673 5692 at the junction with the south-western remainder of Lindhurst Bridleway No.2, (marked A on the order plan), and proceeding for a distance of approximately 112 metres in a north-easterly then east-south-easterly direction on a grass and earth surface to a point, SK 5683 5693, (marked B on the order plan), the junction with the north-eastern remainder of Lindhurst Bridleway No.2, and with a width of 4 metres.

This Order comes into force on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2026 but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act, as amended, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 13<sup>th</sup> May 2026, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
