

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY**

## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EVERTON BRIDLEWAY NO.4) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Everton Bridleway No.4) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025 (which came into force on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025 and was continued by a Continuation Order which remains in force until 29<sup>th</sup> October 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 29<sup>th</sup> October 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed,
- (d) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following length of Bridleway at Everton in the District of Bassetlaw: -

**Everton Bridleway No.4**, (Black Bank Drain) between grid reference points SK 706919 and SK 706920, a distance of approximately 100metres.

**AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that during the period of restriction there are alternative route available.

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to erosion and sink holes and to enable repairs to be made.
