(ASKHAM FOOTPATH No.9) DIVERSION ORDER 2025


This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the public footpath and the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Askham Parish Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Askham and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Askham described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 7396 7613, at the junction with Askham Footpath No. 3 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 580 metres in a generally easterly then south-easterly direction on an earth and grass surface across fields to a point, SK 7441 7587, at the junction with Upton Road and having a width of 1 metre throughout the whole of its length.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 7399 7588, at the junction with Askham Footpath No. 3 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 412 metres in a generally easterly direction to a point, SK 7439 7580, then proceeding for a distance of approximately 90 metres in a generally northerly direction to a point, SK 7441 7587, at the junction with Upton Road on a grass and earth surface of a field edge path and having a width of 1.5 metres throughout the whole of its length.


